Description

Hoop earring is made of round wire. The ends are narrowed and come in one after the other. A pendant in the form of a shell is strung on the ring. It made of two interlocking relief plates, cut according to the contour of the image of a yesso scallop shell. On the sides and below seven miniature pendants in the shape of seashells are attached to the indicated pendant. The surface of each is decorated with convex lines alternating with shallow grooves. Such a fan-shaped decor embodies features of natural shells, so-called "combs". Shell pendants are an imitation of a shaped vial: the upper part of the product resembles a cylindrical neck, separated from the body of a miniature vessel by a relief line.
