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Description

The neck decoration consists of a cross and a hryvna hoop.

A hryvna is a hoop made of four-sided twisted wire. Its ends are closed, one is bent into a loop, the other – into a hook with a spherical tip, the hook is passed through a loop.

Probably, the decoration with a cross testifies to the penetration of Christianity into the cultural space of nomads under influence of the Byzantine Empire.
